JUDGING

Entries will be judged on image impact, clarity, colour, contrast, composition, and lighting. Each category will also have an award for Peoples' Choice. The organisers reserve the right to merge categories depending on the number of entries. Questions may be addressed to Desley Whisson (dwhisson@deakin.edu.au)

COMPETITION RULES

1. Entry is open (and FREE) to all conference registrants.
2. A maximum of two prints per category may be entered (8 entries maximum).
3. Entrants must have taken the photo(s) and have all rights to its/their distribution and use.
4. Entries cannot include photos submitted to a previous AWMS conference.
5. Images may be captured with a digital or film camera. An 8" x 10" printed copy **must** be provided for display at the conference.
6. Entrants **MUST** submit an electronic version (jpeg, bmp or pdf, min. 300 dpi), along with the print for digital display during the conference and to facilitate possible future publication of winning photos. Please bring the electronic version on a memory stick or CD.
7. Entries may be matted or un-matted. No framed prints please.
8. Entries must be labelled on the back with: 1) category, and 2) entrant's name, address, phone number, and e-mail. Velcro tabs will be attached to the back of the mat/mount.
9. Images that have been enhanced by removing scratches or dust, or by making slight alterations that have traditionally been made by filters or in the printing process may be entered.
10. Images that have been extensively altered by double exposure; assembly from two or more images; removal of obstructions or other significant parts; addition, subtraction, or duplication of elements within the image; or other alterations are not permitted.
11. Images of captive/captured animals or propagated plants may be entered, but the entry form and label must clearly indicate the subject matter as such.
12. By submitting your photo(s), you agree to allow AWMS to publish the image(s) in a newsletter or on the webpage, and to display at the Conference.
13. Although all effort will be made to ensure the safety of your photos, AWMS cannot guarantee the security of your photo(s) and take no responsibility for any damage or loss to photos.
14. Winning entries will be announced and displayed at the Conference dinner.
15. All photographs and prizes must be claimed at the end of the conference unless previous arrangements have been made. Unclaimed photographs and prizes will not be returned unless a postage-paid, self-addressed envelope has been provided.
