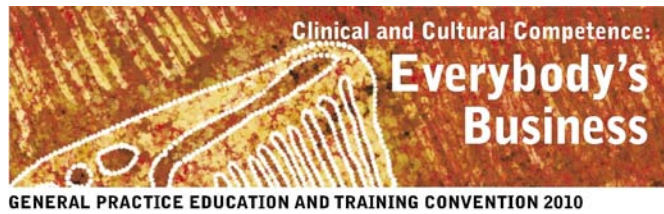


Todd River Regatta
